

ALPACA LACE SCARF

Fingering Weight alpaca yarn (approx 260 yds)

Pattern can be used with your choice of straight needles in sizes 6 through 10. (Sample scarf was knitted on size 7 needles) Smaller needles will result in a tighter lace pattern and smaller scarf. Larger needles will result in a looser, more open lace pattern. Sample to determine your preference.

Cast on 37 stitches, loosely.

Rows 1 and 2: Knit to last stitch, slip 1.

Row 3: (K1, K2tog, K2tog, YO, K1, YO, K1, YO, K1, YO, Slip 1, K1, PSSO, Slip 1, K1, PSSO) repeat to last stitch, Slip 1.

Rows 4, 5 & 6: Knit to last stitch, slip 1.

Repeat rows 3 thru 6 until scarf reaches desired length. End by repeating rows 1 and 2. Cast off loosely. Weave in all yarn ends.

Hand wash in warm water with shampoo or mild dishwashing detergent. Rinse in water of the same temperature. Avoid agitation. Roll in towel to remove excess moisture. Lay flat to dry, open knitting and straighten edges to display lace pattern.



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
